# **RESERVATIONS**

Reservations can be made by calling the Reservation Call Center at 877-CAMP-N-LA (877-226-7652) or by visiting www.ReserveLaStateParks.com. Visitors are welcome to walk in or drive up without a reservation for overnight facilities, but availability may be limited.

The Call Center is open 7:30 a.m. to 6 p.m., Monday through Friday, and is closed on New Year's Day, Good Friday, Independence Day, Labor Day, Veteran's Day, Thanksgiving Day, and Christmas Day.

Payment may be made by credit card — Discover, Visa, MasterCard — in-state personal check or money order. A \$6 non-refundable fee will be assessed on each transaction made. An advance deposit is required for each facility reserved, and must be received within 10 days of the date of the request. Deposits will be applied to the first night's or day's use. For reservations made 10 to 13 months prior to arrival date, the entire reservation balance must be received within 30 days of request.

Cancellation of reservations made 10 to 13 months prior to arrival will result in a one day's rental charge for each facility reserved. Cancellations, on reservations made within 10 months, made 15 or more days prior to arrival will result in a \$10 fee assessed for each facility reserved; cancellations made within 14 days of arrival will result in one day's rental charged for each facility reserved. A change in dates or change in park will be treated like a cancellation and a new reservation must be made.

For overnight facilities, the minimum reservation period during a weekend is two nights. The maximum stay for overnight facilities is 14 consecutive nights, per reservation per park.

# **HOURS OF OPERATION**

State Historic Sites are open 9 a.m. to 5 p.m.; please check www.LaStateParks.com for specific weekday schedules. All State Historic Sites are closed on Thanksgiving, Christmas and New Year's Day.

State Parks entrance stations operate from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. All entrance stations will remain open until 10 p.m. on Fridays, Saturdays and nights before holidays, year around.

Gates at State Parks with boat launches are open from 6 a.m. to 9 p.m., while entrance stations at parks without boat launches operate from 7 a.m. to 9 p.m.

#### **ENTRANCE FEES - DAY USE**

Free for Disabled Veterans with state park permit \$80 Annual Park Pass - valid for day use at all sites

#### STATE PARKS (SP)

\$3 per person Free for Seniors (62 and older)
Free for children age 3 and under Free for school groups on field trips

Hodges Gardens SP: \$7 per person, \$4 for Seniors and free for children age 3 and under. St. Bernard SP: \$2 per person, \$1 for persons age 15 and under.

\$75 per bus used as a Public Conveyance (carrying 20 or more people) at park sites Bus permit required weekends and holidays at park sites (Memorial Day to Labor Day)

#### STATE HISTORIC SITES (SHS)

\$4 per person Free for Seniors (62 and older)
Free for children age 3 and under Free for school groups on field trips

Rosedown Plantation SHS: \$15 per adult (ages 18 to 61), \$10 per senior citizen (62 and older), \$6 per student (ages 4 to 17), free to children 3 and under. Garden Tour only: \$7 per adult (ages 18 and older), \$5 per student (ages 4 to 17), free to children 3 and under.

Free admission to Rosedown Plantation for school groups is limited to self-guided grounds and garden tours only. Field trip tours of the main plantation house require a \$4 per student charge. (Teachers/chaperones are admitted free to the main plantation house while accompanying a scheduled field trip group when the students tour the house.)

**Audubon SHS**: \$10 per adult (ages 18 to 61), \$8 per senior citizen (62 and older), \$5 per student (ages 4 to 17), free to children 3 and under. *Grounds Admission only*: \$5 per person (ages 4 and over) and free to children 3 and under.

Locust Grove SHS and Los Adaes SHS: Admission is free.

#### Fishing Piers and Boating

Use of fishing piers is included with payment of entrance fees.

Visitors are required to abide by the regulations of the Louisiana Department of Wildlife and Fisheries, including the purchase of appropriate fishing license(s).

#### Swimming

Bayou Segnette Wave Pool - \$13 per adult (over 48"), \$10 per child (under 48") per day
Use of all other pools is included with payment of entrance fee.
Wave Pool discounts available when purchased in quantity lots.
Pools open Memorial Day to Aug. 1; open Aug. 1 to Labor Day on modified schedules.
Closed Mondays, except for holiday Mondays. Contact park for hours of operation.

# State Park Operated Rentals - Where Available

Flat bottom boats - \$20 per day- includes vehicle, paddles, life jackets Canoes - \$7 per hour or \$25 per day- includes vehicle, paddles, life jackets Kayaks - \$7 per hour or \$35 per day- includes vehicle, paddles, life jackets Additional life jackets can be rented for \$2 each.

Bicycles - \$7 per hour or \$25 per day

# **Equestrian Trails**

In addition to the day use site entrance fee, an equestrian trail use fee of \$3 is charged per horse at Bogue Chitto, Chemin-A-Haut, Hodges Gardens and Lake Bistineau.

# Off-Highway Vehicle (OHV) Trail

An OHV trail use fee of \$15 per vehicle is charged at South Toledo Bend; an annual pass is available for \$100 per twelve-month period.

### Golf Cart Usage

\$10 per day; an annual permit is available for \$100 per twelve-month period.

### Pet Policy

Any pet brought in to a State Park must be on a leash (not to exceed 6 feet in length), or caged or crated. Pets are not allowed inside any park buildings, including cabins and lodges. Only service dogs are permitted in overnight facilities or near swimming areas. Owners of pets and service dogs are responsible for any injury or damage caused by their pets.
