

REGIONAL OUTDOOR RECREATION PLAN / MAP GUIDELINES – Requirements for LWCF Grant Application

Regional planning for PUBLIC OUTDOOR RECREATION for the area under your jurisdiction (parish, municipality, village, etc.) is a critical component of your grant application. If you have not had a professional plan done for your jurisdiction or parish, you may provide an informal document – we will accept hand written notes on Google Map type format as long as notes are legible on 8 ½ x 11 or 11 x 14 printed format. The purpose of this map is to show all outdoor recreation existing and planned within the Sponsor’s area. Please provide a map legend or color code key and include the following:

Title Block

- Regional Recreation Plan
- Sponsor Name
- Project Name
- City or Town
- Parish
- Date
- Map creator

Identify / Label on Map:

- “PROJECT SITE” - locate with bold red dot & arrow
- Interstates & Roadways
- North Arrow
- LWCF Sites – use star symbol and Park Name
- Planned Park Sites – can be labeled “future park, trail or launch”
- Existing Parks & Outdoor Recreation Facilities
- Lakes, Rivers and Bayous
- Trails existing or planned
- Recreation Facilities (commercial & membership) such as YMCA
- Boat launches
- Campgrounds & RV Parks
- Schools with playgrounds and play fields
- Vacant land owned by sponsor & earmarked for recreation
